

Understanding Wakatipu High School Homestay Costs

 - Intense Competition for Accommodation: A substantial portion of available housing is often converted into more lucrative short-term holiday rentals (like Airbnb), further reducing the supply of long-term rentals for residents and workers. This creates intense competition and drives up rental prices for everyone.
 - Competition for Host Families: Wakatipu High School competes for potential homestay families not only with the general high cost of living but also with other educational institutions, such as language schools in Queenstown, and with the significant demand for affordable short-term accommodation from migrant and seasonal workers. These groups also seek available rooms, adding pressure on the limited housing pool suitable for homestays.
 - Higher Costs for Goods and Services: Due to Queenstown's relatively remote location compared to larger New Zealand cities like Auckland or Christchurch, the costs for everyday goods and food can be higher. This is largely attributable to increased freight and transport expenses incurred to bring supplies into the region. This elevated cost of living impacts host families' household budgets directly.
 - Strong Tourism Economy: A robust tourism sector drives up demand for all services and resources, which translates into higher prices for goods and services across the board.
- 2. Impact of High Costs on Homestay Providers: Given the overall high cost of living in Queenstown, including elevated housing expenses and the increased price of goods and services, homestay families themselves face higher personal and household expenditures. To ensure they can continue to provide a comfortable home, nutritious meals, and a supportive environment for international students, the homestay fees must adequately compensate them for these increased costs and for their time and resources.
- 3. **Quality of Accommodation and Support**: The homestay program at Wakatipu High School is committed to providing high-quality, safe, and supportive environments for international students. This includes:





- Vetted Host Families: Host families undergo rigorous screening processes and and are compensated to ensure they can provide a comfortable home, nutritious meals, and a supportive family environment.
- Comprehensive Support: The fees also contribute to the administrative costs of managing the homestay program, including student welfare support, emergency assistance, and ongoing communication with families and agents.
- 4. <u>Comparison to Global High-Value Destinations</u>: The situation in Queenstown is comparable to other international destinations that are highly sought after for their natural beauty, recreational opportunities, and exclusive appeal.
 - Aspen, Colorado (USA): Known for its world-class skiing and luxury tourism, Aspen faces extremely high property values and a cost of living that far exceeds other parts of Colorado or the United States. Accommodation, even for long-term residents, is premium.
 - Other Examples: Many island nations or cities with unique geographical constraints (e.g., Monaco, parts of Switzerland, certain coastal Australian towns) experience similar dynamics where desirability and limited space drive up costs significantly.
